Monthly themes.

The themes for this month are; 'Getting to know you' and the colour YELLOW. Below are some activities that you can do with your child at home:

- Talk to your child at home about the names of the staff (the teacher-Mrs McLaughlin and the Nursery assistant Mrs Rabbett.)
- Encourage your child to say their name and to enter classroom themselves.
- Be positive in your conversation. Nursery is a happy place.
- Praise all your child's efforts and display his/her work at home.
- Point out the colour YELLOW at home and in the environment.
- Recite the songs and Nursery rhymes with your children.
- Encourage your child to put on and take off their own coats.



Reminders

- Please remember to label all jumpers and coats with your child's name.
- Nursery starts at 9.00 am . It is essential that all children are in class at this time so that they can participate in our "Meet And Greet" session.
- Please collect your child on time as the children can become distressed waiting after others have left.
- The children will be playing outside each day, please ensure that they have warm outdoor clothing and suitable footwear with them at all times.
- If anyone different is collecting your child, please let a member of staff know in the morning. (This must be someone over 16.) Inform the teacher of any changes of address / contact details/medical information.
- Please bring a change of clothes for your child and a box of tissues and hand sanitiser.
- Read through our Child Protection Policy and Behaviour Management Policy on website. Please ask if you need any clarification.


