Themes

The themes for this month are: settling into school and 'A time to rhyme'.

- Try to encourage your child to go to bed early so he/she is ready for the school day.
- Children and parents arriving between 8.45 and 9 a.m. must go to the shared area where they will be supervised.
- Arriving late can make some children unsettled; try to be in class before 9.10am.
 After this time the only access to the school is through the main doors at the front of the building.
- Please make sure your child's name is on their school jumper.
- Please ensure that your child brings a school bag to school every day.

Number

Oral counting to 10. Recite rhymes and sing songs e.g. 1, 2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive, 1, 2 buckle my shoe etc. We will be focusing on the numbers 1 and 2 this month, encourage your child to practice writing these numbers on chalk boards, whiteboards, paper etc.



Language

Share stories and Nursery Rhymes with your child and discuss them. We will be focusing on 'Incy Wincy spider', 'Hickory, Dickory Dock', 'Humpty, Dumpty' and 'Wee Willy Winky'. Discuss these characters, why could they not put Humpty together again? Why did 'Wee Willy winky' have a candle?




September in Year

In Year 1 we will be following our School's healthy eating policy. Your child will receive a nutritious break of fruit and yoghurts.
